Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Registered and active parishioners should call the office well-ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

From Your Priests

Merry Christmas and Happy Epiphany! Among the gems of Catholic Tradition is the continuance of the Christmas season throughout the 12 Days of Christmas (December 25 through January 5), then Epiphany and its former Octave (January 6-13) and even until the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin on February 2). I will be leaving today to celebrate Christmas with my family in the Northern states and return for next Sunday). There will be no public Vespers today as Fr. Rice is still not comfortable leading the chants.

I am pleased to announce that we have filled our Parish Business Administrator position. Deacon Jonathan Messer started in that role last week and replaces Louis Derise who sadly had to step down because of his unsustainable commute. Deacon Jon is ordained in the Ukrainian Rite, one of the Eastern Rites of the Catholic Church fully in union with Rome, and serves his parish in Manchester on Sundays. In many of the Eastern Rites, the long tradition is married clergy so Deacon Jon has a family and works to support them. He brings much experience to the position and is a welcome addition to our parish staff. Please help me welcome Deacon Jon to our parish.

Parish Announcements

Epiphany water has been blessed to sprinkle in your homes throughout the Christmas season, which does not end until February 2. Bring some home in your own (reasonably-sized) container while it lasts.

Take a piece of chalk which was blessed on the Epiphany and have the head of the household write the following inscription above your front door:

20 + C + M + B + 24

This represents the year (2024) and the initials of the 3 Kings, Caspar, Melchior and Bathasar. Epiphany water should be sprinkled in all the rooms of the house by the head of the household as well as Father did a general blessing of all your homes on the feast.

Parish Announcements



Announcing:

The cooperative parking agreement between us and our neighbor who owns the five gated lots to the left of the Church is in effect:

- **On Sundays ONLY**, from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
- The **Third and Fourth gated lots** from the Church will be **open to St. Stanislaus**.
- In exchange, **those attending St. Stanislaus are asked NOT TO PARK in any of the Triangle Credit Union (TCU) spaces beyond the main TCU lighted sign**. St. Stanislaus attendees are asked to only park in the marked spaces between our Church and the TCU lighted sign (and no farther beyond the bank building). In addition, **none of the other gated lots are available to St. Stanislaus** at any time, including Sundays.
- This agreement applies **only on Sundays between 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.** All cars in the Third and Fourth gated lots outside of those times are subject to tow or being locked in.

The New Schedule for Blessings is in Effect:

The first Sunday of each month (today): The General Blessing of All Objects, the Blessing of Rosaries, and the Blessing of Expectant Mothers only will be given after each Mass. You may bring anything to be blessed, but items with a special blessing, such as St. Benedict Medals, candles, olive oil, etc. should be blessed with their particular blessings at the times noted below.

The second Saturday of each month: After the 9 a.m. Mass, all blessings will be available, including brown scapular enrollments and other such enrollments.

The Blessing of Salt: There is not a specific blessing for salt but it is blessed as part of the making of Holy Water. This is done as needed, about every 3 weeks or so. Those wanting blessed salt should put it under the Holy Water tank near the St. Joseph altar, labeled with your name. When the priest makes new Holy Water he will also bless the salt and put an indication on it that it is blessed. Once blessed, the salt will be moved to the Church basement under the lost and found shelf.

When circumstances arise for blessings outside of those times, you are welcome to ask and we will usually be able to accommodate you. We only ask that you do not leave items to be blessed as we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.
