Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Registered and active parishioners should call the office well-ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

From Your Priests

Fr. John Brancich, FSSP, Pastor

I invite everyone to come downstairs after any Mass today to hear a brief presentation from one of your fellow parishioners. They will give more information about our *Ad Altare Dei* Capital Campaign, including why they belong to Saint Stanislaus Church and why they are supporting the campaign. You will be able to take a full-color campaign brochure which will present the case statement and provide details about the projects to be addressed through this campaign.

I am happy and somewhat relieved that I was finally able to announce to the whole parish this campaign. Your fellow parishioners on the Campaign Cabinet, our staff, and I have been working on this campaign in the silent phase for over a year. At some points over the past months, it has required a majority of my time. The campaign, the four months without an assistant priest, and the efforts to create and hire new staff positions really limited my ability to attend to the (much more important) pastoral functions of the parish – the ones I would much rather be doing. One of the areas where we are especially behind because of this is the Sacrament preparation program. It will happen this year; obviously (at this point) not on the usual schedule. We hope to have the program started in a few weeks so please continue to be patient and watch the bulletin for information.

Please pray for the 10 couples preparing for marriage in the upcoming months. This, too, requires a significant time commitment from the priests. I mention these things to help you understand why sometimes it takes a long time for your requests to be addressed.

Parish Announcements *(cont'd)*

Saturday, February 3 is the Feast of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, who lived around the year 316 A.D. He is noted for curing a young boy who was brought to him with a fish bone stuck in his throat and because of this, there is a special blessing of throats on this day after Mass. Two crossed candles are held on the throat while the priest says, "Per intercessionem Sancti Blasii liberet te Deus a malo gutteris et a quovis alio malo" (May God at the intercession of St. Blaise preserve you from throat troubles and every other evil). The Blessing of Throats will be Saturday after the 9 a.m. Mass (after the First Saturday devotions) and other times that day if requested.

This Friday, February 2 is Candlemas, the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This day, the end of the extended Christmas season, is marked with a blessing of and procession with candles to be used in the upcoming year. This ceremony will take place at the beginning of the 6:30 p.m. High Mass. If you have candles you would like blessed during the ceremony, please bring them to the designated spot near the Communion rail before 5:50 p.m. Candles will also be available for a small donation. After the candles are blessed, candles for the procession are distributed at the Communion Rail. Anyone may receive one and when the priest presents it to you, kiss the candle first and then his hand (you may omit this ceremonial kiss if you have any health concerns). Once the servers and priest begin the procession, the faithful may follow holding their lighted candles if they wish. This is normally an indoor procession but to accommodate our large numbers we will process outside around the Church. Dress accordingly if you wish to process. (The parish group banners are not used in this procession.) You may take the candle home and burn it during storms, times of sickness and anxiety, etc.

The Cooperative Parking Agreement between us and our neighbor who owns the five gated lots to the left of the Church is in effect:

- ◆ **On Sundays ONLY**, from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
- ◆ **The Third and Fourth gated lots** from the Church will be **open to St. Stanislaus**.
- ◆ **In exchange, those attending St. Stanislaus are asked NOT TO PARK in any of the Triangle Credit Union (TCU) spaces beyond the main TCU lighted sign.** St. Stanislaus attendees are asked to only park in the marked spaces between our Church and the TCU lighted sign (and no farther beyond the bank building). In addition, **none of the other gated lots are available to St. Stanislaus** at any time, including Sundays.
- ◆ **This agreement applies only on Sundays between 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.** All cars in the Third and Fourth gated lots outside of those times are subject to tow or being locked in.
