**Tuesday, March 25 is the Feast of the Annunciation** of the Blessed Mary. Nine months before Christmas Day, this day celebrates the "Fiat" ("Let it be done") of Our Lady's response to the angel Gabriel's message from God asking her to be the mother of His Son. In addition to the usual 12:10 p.m. Low Mass, there will be a High Mass that evening at 6:30 p.m.

**Some people have been writing "Restricted"** on their contributions to the parish, thinking that this somehow exempts their donation from being included in the calculation of the diocesan assessments. We are not sure where this idea is coming from, but it is not true. As it is said, "the only two things certain are death and taxes," and this applies in the Church as well. Saint Stanislaus Catholic Church is not an independent church, we are part of the Catholic Church united to Rome through our local bishop. Contributions to our *Ad Altare Dei Capital Campaign* are exempt from diocesan taxes 100%, and the full amount of your contributions goes directly to our parish with no effect on our assessment amounts. You can still make contributions to the Capital Campaign and they will be put to good use on the projects that are set to begin very soon.

### Corpus Christi Food Pantry

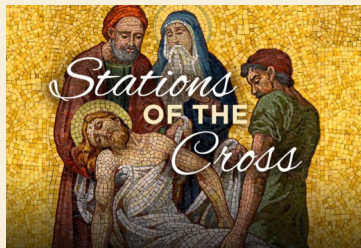

## Sacraments

*The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish*

**Baptisms** - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

**Holy Matrimony** - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

**First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion** - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.
