From Your Priests



Fr. John Brancich, FSSP, Pastor

We are approaching the 25th Anniversary of the death of His Eminence, Ignatius Cardinal Kung Pin-Mei, a faithful Catholic bishop who was imprisoned by the Communist Party in China from 1950 through 1985, and then under house arrest until his nephew brought him to the U.S. in 1988. It was my honor to be asked, in 2023, to serve on the Board of Advisors for the Cardinal Kung Foundation, who support the persecuted underground Catholic Church in China. This weekend, the Advisors, along with some supporters, are visiting the tomb of Cardinal Kung in California to pray especially on his anniversary. Indeed, just this past week, another faithful underground Catholic priest was arrested and has disappeared for offering an “unauthorized Mass” on December 27. The persecution of those Catholics faithful to Rome and not to the Communist party continues and intensifies. Parish Announcements

Receiving palms on Palm Sunday (April 13th this year) is an important start to Holy Week and can only be done once the blessing of and procession with palms is completed. This year, there will be no Low Mass before this solemn blessing and procession. This ceremony will take place at 8:30 a.m., followed by the Solemn High Mass of Palm Sunday. Immediately after the blessing and procession, there will also be a Low Mass offered in the Church basement (at the same time as the High Mass upstairs). This will be the first Low Mass of the day, and another Low Mass will be offered at 12:30 p.m. This will allow even those who want to attend a Low Mass to be present for the blessing and procession, and everyone will be able to receive palms regardless of when you attend Mass that day.

Each family may submit *one scheduled* Mass Intention per month. The priests are not accepting private Mass Intentions at this time.

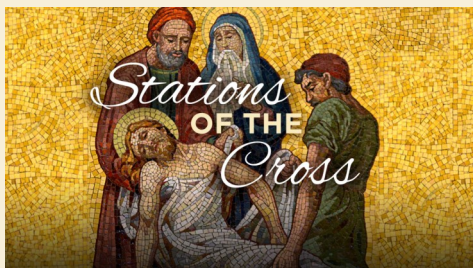

Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

He is the Principal Patron of the Diocese of Manchester among many other things, including Patron of the Universal Church. This is a First Class Feast. In addition to the 8 a.m. Low Mass, there will be a **Solemn High Mass at 6:30 p.m.**



St. Joseph's Table

Please join us in honoring St. Joseph after the evening Solemn High Mass on Wednesday, March 19. A traditional St. Joseph's Table will be set up in the main room in the basement upon which the faithful are invited to place traditional food offerings, before (starting at 5 pm) or shortly following the Mass, such as:

- Breads, particularly sesame-anise bread, in shapes of various Catholic symbols: St. Joseph's staff, various carpentry tools (hammer, saw, nails, etc.), chalice, cross, monstrance, dove, lamb, fish, heart, etc.
- Raw fava beans and dishes made of fava beans
- Fruits: oranges, lemons, grapes, apples, pears, pineapples, and bananas
- Vegetables: Artichokes, artichoke stems, fried cauliflower, and seafood-stuffed bell peppers
- Fresh salads
- Various Italian cookies, feast zeppoles (fried dough and powdered sugar), and St. Joseph sfingi/zeppoles (a round cream puff filled with cream and adorned with candied fruits)

Devotions will be prayed around the Table, the Table and offerings will be blessed, and then all can partake.
