Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Registered and active parishioners should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

Let it be known to all here  present that Christopher Desrosiers, son of William and Tabatha of the Desrosiers family, and Honora Kelly, daughter of James and Rebecca of the Kelly family, intend to contract marriage between themselves. Therefore, we admonish all that if anyone is aware of any existing impediment that would prohibit marriage between them, that he is obligated to reveal it as soon as possible to the Pastor or the Bishop, and this serves as the first publication of these Banns.

We not only met our goal, but we even surpassed our stretch goal. I am both joyful and grateful as I reflect on the tremendous success we have had. Your prayers and financial generosity made it possible. You will be able to find an updated list of all donors to the campaign in today’s bulletin.

I want to extend a heartfelt thank you to all the volunteers and staff who worked so hard on this, our first major fundraising effort for the parish, from the volunteers who organized events and distributed information packets about our campaign to the staff who labored over the logistical and financial details. Your hard work and enthusiasm have been a shining example of your Catholic Faith. All these efforts, combined with your pledges and contributions, are a testament to the support of our Traditional Latin Mass parish in New Hampshire.

The redemption phase of our campaign will begin in May. This will be crucial in ensuring that our projects move forward. Please pray for the successful completion of these projects. The organ project has been approved by the diocese, and the Wallace Organ Company will remove the entire organ this week to begin the restoration work. We are working with an engineer to solicit bids for the structural work in the attic which we hope to begin in May. I am meeting with potential Church art companies to develop plans for the interior renovation. You will see much happening in the upcoming weeks and months!

All glory be to God for our success and to His Mother Mary, to whom we have been entrusting this entire work as we prayed the *Sub Tuum Praesidium* (We Fly to Thy Protection) over the past year as our Campaign Prayer. May she continue to intercede for us as we begin the projects that this Campaign and your support have made possible.
