**Wednesday, May 7 is the Feast** of Saint Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr. He was a Polish bishop who was murdered in 1079 A.D. at the command of the King while saying Mass. He is the patron of our parish, so the "External Solemnity" of his feast will be observed next Sunday, May 4 with the St. Stanislaus propers from May 7 used for the 7 & 11 a.m. Masses.



## Blessings at Saint Stanislaus

### The first Sunday of each month:

The General Blessing of All Objects, the Blessing of Rosaries, and the Blessing of Expectant Mothers only will be given after each Mass. You may bring anything to be blessed, but items with a special blessing should be blessed with their particular blessings at the times noted below.



### The second Saturday of each month:

After the 9 a.m. Mass, all blessings will be available, including brown scapular enrollments and other such enrollments.

### The Blessing of Salt:

Those wanting salt blessed should put it under the holy water tank near the St. Joseph altar, labeled with your name. Once blessed, the salt will be moved for pick-up to the Church basement under the lost and found shelf. **Please do not put salt under the holy water tank unless the tank is less than ¼ full, to prevent a pile-up of salt weeks before it will be blessed.**

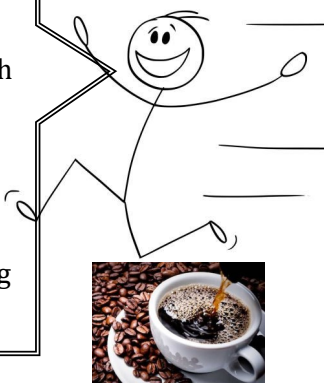

## Sacraments

*The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish*

**Baptisms** - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

**Holy Matrimony** - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

**First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion** - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

**The Nashua Holy League for men** will meet on **Thursday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, at 6:30 p.m.** The Holy League meets on the first Thursday of each month for silent prayer, Benediction, confession and a social hour. All men are invited to attend.

### **A word about First Friday and First Saturday.**

The interest and participation in our First Friday and First Saturday devotions is encouraging. Our Lord asked for the First Friday of each month to be dedicated to reparation to His Sacred Heart. Our Lady asked for reparation to her Immaculate Heart on the First Saturdays of the month.

Although every First Friday and First Saturday should, ideally, be dedicated to fulfilling these requests, there are specific requests from Heaven for what are known as the "Nine Consecutive First Fridays" and the "Five Consecutive First Saturdays." The only requirement for the "Nine First Fridays" is to receive Holy Communion in reparation to the Sacred Heart on nine First Fridays in a row. Confession is not specifically a requirement, but of course Holy Communion must be received in the state of grace, so confession may be necessary if that is not the case (and it doesn't have to be on Friday).

Going to confession is a requirement to fulfil the nine First Saturdays, but Our Lady said this can be done up to one week before or after the First Saturday. Confession does not have to be received on the First Saturday itself, like some of the other First Saturday requirements. Again, confession for First Saturday can be received in any of the 7 days before or after the First Saturday.

Please consider making your confession on days other than the First Saturday itself, as the lines can be very long on the day itself. If those who are able to confess on other days would do so, it would be a great charity to those who are unable to do so on these days by greatly reducing the wait time for someone who needs to confess on this day. Thank you for your consideration and charity.
