With the Ad Altare Dei Capital Campaign having just concluded, we are wasting no time in getting started on the projects for which we raised the money. The Wallace Organ Company from Gorham, Maine was awarded the project to remove, restore, augment, and reinstall our historic pipe organ. The building structure project in the Church attic needs to be completed before beginning most of the other projects. Because the only access to the attic was literally “through” the pipe organ, Wallace Company came in early this week and carefully removed the organ. They meticulously packed and protected the roughly 50% of the pipes and other parts that will be incorporated into the new organ. Over the next two years, they will complete the “new” organ, reinstalling it hopefully in 2027. In the meantime, they have provided us a small pipe organ that their company has built. While nowhere near the size of our previous or future organ, it should serve us well in the interim. It is a blessing to be able to have a temporary instrument that is a true “pipe organ” since that is what the Church says has the “pride of place” among instruments for sacred Church music.
