From Your Priests

At last Sunday's Masses, I gave a brief overview of where we stand with each of the projects from our *Ad Altare Dei Capital Campaign*. Every single one of the projects for which we raised the funds is either 1) completed 2) in progress or 3) approved and scheduled to begin in the near future. Over the next few weeks, I would like to speak in a bit more detail about each of the projects and the status of it. This week I will begin with the **Church Structural Repair and Enhancement** which is complete! This project had to be done before other projects could begin. Because of how the Church was constructed over 100 years ago, there was enough movement in the attic structure during wind that the Church would move back and forth slightly—causing the plaster to crack and requiring repair and repainting every 20 years or so. We engaged North Branch Construction, one of the top firms in the state, to modify that structure and stop the movement. The project was successful even though it required some thinking “outside the box” by North Branch because of a few unexpected hidden challenges that arise in a historic building such as ours.

Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.
