Father Rock will, perhaps, give you a more complete introduction to himself in the future, but for today, we print the following short bio, courtesy of Regina Cœli Parish in Houston, Texas, his former assignment:



"Fr. William Rock, FSSP was ordained to the Catholic Priesthood on Oct. 26, 2019, at St. Mary's Church in Providence, Rhode Island by Bishop Athanasius Schneider, ORC, of Kazakhstan. In his childhood, Father felt the call to Priesthood yet began his official discernment during his last year of college at Virginia Tech. After graduating with a degree in Aerospace Engineering, Father spent four years in the US Air Force before entering Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary in the Fall of 2011. As he grew in his faith, a desire arose for a priestly formation and Catholic life as it had been experienced by generations of Catholics before him. By bringing him to the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter, God fulfilled the desire which He Himself had no doubt planted."

## Sacraments

**Baptisms** - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

**Holy Matrimony** - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

**First Confession, Confirmation & First**

**Communion** - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.

### Statement from Bishop Libasci on the assassination attempt of former President Donald Trump:

"We are shocked and greatly concerned by the occurrences of July 13. We mourn the loss of life, and we regret with the most profound sadness that such a moment has again made its way into our national consciousness. Life has been threatened and lives have been taken and there is evidence that acts of violence are chosen by those for whom rational discourse and amicable disagreement are seen more as a humiliation opposed to the nobility of civilized society.
