My vacation turned out to hold unexpected "adventures": a lost wallet (and thus no money in a foreign country) and a broken smartphone to name two. But most were very positive adventures as I was in Poland for a reunion with some of my seminary classmates. One of my classmates is Polish and

is stationed in Cracow, so he brought us to many beautiful Churches, shrines and historic sites. It was my first time there and I was struck by how Catholic the country still is. Most of the people greeted us priests very enthusiastically with a religious greeting, the Mass attendance is extremely high, there is not

abortion on demand and so there are children, youth and young adults everywhere. We also had the good fortune of being at the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa on the day before her Feast which saw thousands of young pilgrims arrive by foot after 8-10 days of walking on a pilgrimage.
