**Parish Registration** will begin later this week. Please watch our website [www.latinmassnashua.org](http://www.latinmassnashua.org) for information on the registration process. For those without Internet access, a hard-copy registration form will be provided to complete the process.

**An organizational and basic training meeting for Altar Servers** will be held today at 12:00 Noon in the Church. All boys and men who are either currently serving or who would like to learn how to serve are asked to attend this meeting. Father will discuss the serving program at our parish and provide some information and training on the ceremonies at St. Stanislaus. The meeting will end promptly at 12:45, and pizza will be provided to those attending the meeting in the rectory basement classroom after Mass. The classroom is accessible through the Church basement behind the kitchen. The meeting will take place in the Church.

**All brochures, booklets, books, posters, pictures** or anything else set out, distributed or posted in the Church must first be submitted to the office for approval by the Pastor. Anything put out without approval will be discarded. Thank you for your cooperation.

**Installation of the Pastor Ceremony.** Fr. Brancich will be installed as the Pastor of St. Stanislaus Parish by the Vicar Forane (Dean) of the Souhegan Deanery, the Very Rev. John M. Grace, V.F., on Sunday, October 2, 2016 at 12:30 p.m. at St. Stanislaus Church. Father Grace will be representing His Excellency Bishop Libasci. During the ceremony, the Dean, on behalf of the Bishop, presents and hands over to the new Pastor the various aspects and functions of the parish: the keys of the church, the missal, the altar, credence table, main door of the church, bells, and pulpit. The new Pastor makes the Profession of Faith and recites the Anti-Modernist Oath. After the usual 10 a.m. High Mass, there will be no coffee and donut reception. Instead, the Blessed Sacrament will be Exposed and remain so 12:15 p.m. at which time Benediction will be given. The Installation of the Pastor Ceremony will begin at 12:30 p.m. and will last about 30 minutes. Afterwards, there will be a potluck brunch/lunch in the Church basement with overflow in the rectory basement (accessible through the tunnel). Please bring a dish to share. Cake and coffee, plates, cups, utensils, etc. will be provided.
